ELECTED **	Elected by the MNA House of Delegates	
Vice President	Assumes all duties of the president in the President's absence.	LBU Member
Secretary	Accountable for record keeping and reporting of meetings of MNA.	LBU Member
Board of Directors (6)	Responsible to implement the objectives and directives of the MNA House of Delegates and to transact the affairs of MNA between annual meetings.	LBU Members
Impartial Committee (2)	Investigates complaints and recommends action against members in violation of MNA bylaws or policies. (4 members plus 1 board member appointed by President)	LBU Members
Nominations Committee (2)	Develops the slate of candidates for elective offices for MNA officers and the Impartial and the Nominations committees. Implements the MNA Awards Program. (5 members)	LBU Members
APPOINTED **	Appointed by the MNA Board of Directors	
Council on Clinical Nursing Practice, Advocacy & Education (2)	Responsible for fulfilling the House of Delegates priorities related to the issues of nursing practice. (5 or more members)	All Members
Council on Legislation and Public Policy (2)	Responsible for fulfilling the House of Delegates priorities related to the issues of nursing & health care policy. (5 or more members)	All Members
Council on Workplace Health & Safety (2)	Responsible for fulfilling the MNA House of Delegates priorities related to emerging trends and issues related to workplace health and safety. (5 or more members)	All Members
Bylaws Committee (2)	Oversees changes to MNA bylaws, standing rules and procedures. (5 members)	LBU Members
CE Provider Unit (2)	Oversees provider status of continuing education for MNA. (5 members; 2 with an advanced degree)	All Members (CE experience)
Diversity, Inclusion & Cultural Competency Committee (2)	Develops and cultivates inclusiveness by providing education, tools and other resources to promote diversity and cultural competency. (5 members)	All Members
Resolution Committee (3)	Oversees the formal process for proposal submission to the MNA House of Delegates. (6 members plus one board member)	LBU Members
Retirement Committee (3)	The Retirement committee educates and mobilizes retired nurses on issues that affect both working and retired nurses. (6 members)	Retired members
MNA-PAC (6)	Serves to increase the political influence of the nursing profession in planning, providing and evaluating health care. (11 members)	All Members
